Mabel's mother Roy wife & child came a few

days ago and left this AM.

The children are having a good time playing & fighting altho there are a lot of mosquitos & wood ticks. There have been 6 deaths in the valley from tick fever so I am concerned everytime I catch one on the kids.

I hope you are feeling better all the time and are not too lonesome - I am anxious to get back to see you - Drives you too.

I have invited Norma Jean & Maryda to ride back with me. I hate to cross the desert alone but we think I should pay Maryda's way back but I can't do that because I know I'll have to spend money on them there as she may not come & I can't help it - Norma will tho. Bill Carroll came up for a few days but hurt his knee & went back. Butch sent a check to Risk for his birthday and there was \$10 for you I'll bring \$1. Lots of love from us all - Ida -
