The schools in Portland are more advanced in English ^{more} than Long Beach. There were 4 other girls that came from the vicinity of Long Beach and we got to gether to learn our English which made it lots easier.

I'm sorry to hear about the Wards. I have been wondering what was wrong because Dick never answered my last two letters. I think that Mae could have been a nice girl if her mother and father had taken an interest in her.

I'm writing this in school and I think that maybe Aunt Esther will write to you to night, if we stay home. (she says she ^{fell} ~~is getting~~ ^{like even} night she ^{had} ~~had~~ tired)

we have to get up early eat. They go to work. Then it's nearly 7:00 o'clock when they get home. Then nearly every night they go some place or some one comes over.

Phil is sure a big boy he's 6 ft 3 in tall. ^(he's on the team at Lincoln) he practices ~~baseball~~ every afternoon and get home with his mother and father so I stay at a girl's house and do my studying then we go skating. ^(Thanks to Uncle Kenneth)

I've made two netted pieces since I've been here. I gave one to Aunt Esther for Xmas and have one done to give her for her birthday this month.

I sure would like to see Beaulah Lee it sort of lonesome without little kids around.

Aunt Esther and I went to see "Country Doctor" last night and the quintuplets are so cute I imagined what Beaulah Lee was like. Give her a squeeze for me. Well it's almost the end of the period and I'll have to stop for we have an assembly next period. Give my love to Aunt ~~Ida~~ ^{and} family. I'll try to write more often. Write and ask mother how often I write to her then you'll understand.
