Dear Daughter Clara

I will try and answer your most welcome letter your Father has the tooth ache a good deal of time and I have quit drinking Tea and coffee so I have the head ache most all the time but I am getting over it I wish I was well other ways I hope you will try and come to Logan before I go to Arizona Elle is coming in Oct and I expect to go back with him

I hope I can get your quilts done
before I go I expect to stay all
winter if I go the folks out
there are going to put together
and raise the money to pay
my fare there Jane and All
Kempton sent me their pictures
they look natural Charley
Hancock's two sons was here
yesterday to see me Mame's little
girl came with her Father
Roland came from Preston and
took Mame and her company up
to Preston to a masked ball on
Washington's birthday Henry
took our team and Roxie went
with him and Flossie (that is his
girl) to the ball to Preston

they all took quilts and
pillows and Roxie took her bed
they all stayed to dinner
and had a good time
How many cows do you milk
now. our cows are dry and so is
the chickens I guess for I
do not get any eggs this
winter that is the reason that
I cannot get any writing
material so If you do not get
any letters ~~one~~ from me you
will know why but you must
write all the same if you can
I should think it would be
cheaper to sell the hogs than
it would be to keep them
even if you did not get as much
as you ought too
