Dear Mother Keam,

I have long wanted to write, but time seems to have wings for I get so little done of what I plan and hope to.

We enjoyed your letter a great deal and will give your suggestion serious consideration. We have often thought of it and would have liked to have made it double when Milton did years ago.

We are glad you all enjoyed the turkey. The birds did real well this year, being as nice looking as any birds to go thru the plant. It was a most interesting trip to me, when Mrs. Spencer and I went down with Rodney early one morning and came back with Horsley in the late afternoon - the latter took a load of birds down. I had never been to the plant. German war prisoners did the heavy work, while high school girls did the
