The children are having a good time playing & fighting altho there are a lot of Mosquitos & wood ticks. There have been 6 deaths in the valley from Tick fever so I am concerned every time I catch one on the the kids.

I hope you are feeling better all the time and are not too lonesome. I am anxious to get back to see you - I miss you too.

I have invited Norma Jean & Mary Ida to ride back with me. I hate to cross the desert alone but W.C. thinks I should go Mary Ida's way back but I can't do that because I know I'll have to spend money on them there so she may not come & I can't help it. Norma will tho. Bill Carroll came up for a few days but hurt his knee & went back. Beulah sent a check to Rich for his birthday and there was 10 for you. I'll bring it. Lots of love from us all.
