I was trying to fence a new yard at the Buckley place & lifting & sawing qualawash poles for posts & braces I hurt my side and my rupture is down badly all the time now Well I am going some but so good as I was but I want to see the haying thru & then I am off I think. Well I sure was disappointed at you not getting a long better. I can just imagine at Dug's I guess you had no better try coming out when you get back to L.B. I believe you will get all right. About Nov. 11. If I am not in the hospital and can go at all I will be in L.B. then if it is only for a short time. Things are not going as good as they should I don't see the future as clear as I did 2 yrs ago If I could have got things I tried & wanted it would have been a fine thing I can't see as clearly a bout the conditions now as then. We have a big hay crop & I don't believe there will be any sale at any price My share of grain will be about all the chaff & that won't be near enough to satisfy the one I am supposed to pay Well I can only make the best out of the stuff we've

I have just been sleeping + got up. so I'll write
a line before I eat a bite. every one is off to day + it has
been so hot all wk. + all the teams are tired. Just one
man raking + he will soon be in + the rest of the day
nothing doing so I will write KD, a letter got one from
him same day I got yours. He seems to be feeling Ok.
But I think a little home sick. I wish he was here I
would like to see him + I sure need him to help me
now, but, it like he will not be back till + other year
He expects a raise in wages next Nov. then he may
come home on a visit. Well all are apparantly well. Leo
Peters fell off the bed last night + got a bad bump
on the head + seems very peevish to day. He has
the Summer complaint like little Bill + it is so
very hot it might develop to something bad I am a
fraid of it. So bad you could not get here to see him
+ Lee Clark. He to me does not look to well + seems to
be fainting as good as he should + does not have a good
healthy look. Wish you could see them both. There is
a lot you would like to know + it does not pay to put it
on paper in writing. Well I hope you are better and do not
go to the hospital for some time yet stay with Dug, a while + have a good
visit if the family I know by staying there that your
health will be much better + it maybe you could come out
see us all here. I hope so. But dare not to advise you to be in
