Aug 1, 1933

Dear Mother,

I have been going to write you for some time but just have not arrived at it until now. I hope all of you down there are well & doing fine. We are all the same as usual here. Dad feels kinda punk at times but at others feels good & gets out and works a little.

It has been good & warm here (96° in the shade) but it rained a little last night & cooled things off considerable. Quite nice this morning.

We have been haying for the last ten days & every thing is going fine. hope it is as well with you. If there is any real news Dad has probably told it to you at least I can't recall any sight now that would be of any interest so, will get to work & write more next time.

I am sending you Fifteen (\$15.00)

dollars to come upon & hope to see you soon I would be best to wait until after the middle of August when it will not be so hot as it is now.
