Dear Dad,

I was sure glad to get your letter and know that you are all Ok. We are all in the best of health up here with the exception of a cold now and then. I didn't tell you before but I received the lemons & the Texas package Ok I was sure glad to get them.

The Starkelly men were over on the 13th & paid the balance on the hay which was \$95.00. I was sure glad to get the deal straightened up. They had 9.28 tons of old hay. All the new hay is listed on the sheet I am enclosing. I am also enclosing a map of the place with the stacks on it with the exception of that which is on the north side of the home place. I do not know what part of that you intend to keep if any. We have as yet 300 tons of hay on hand. Rodney told me the other day he wanted two stacks of good hay.

Spencer pulled in to the Peterson ~~place~~ place
 the other day & I had to put up a row of fence
 to keep the horses out of his sheep. That is all
 done now & every thing is going off here. I have
 now \$500⁰⁰ dollars on hand. Below is a list of
