Mr. Kenneth Ream, Dingle, Idaho, has been listed in the records of this office as next of kin for the parcel label privilege in behalf of Dr. Allen and her two children. If and when transportation facilities again become available for the purpose of sending parcels to the Orient, he will be forwarded the necessary labels and instructions.

There is no record in the files of this office of Lieutenant Colonel Henderson Wilcox Allen. It is suggested that you direct your inquiry concerning him to the Adjutant General's Office, Washington, D. C.
