thankful you were to let us

You have surely taken an
interest in our place, but we
do have very poor soil here
and not enough time to work out-
side. I think I ought to get
the work done inside first.
People surely admire our roses.

I hope I can go to Bear
Lake this summer - take the
children. They haven't been
for two years. I had thought
of going for Decoration Day,
but have decided I shouldn't
take the children out of school.
They would miss two weeks -
will try and go later if I can
get someone to stay here.

I was unable to finish this the 17th, but will try to now. Next Saturday - the 21st - my mother would have been 65. That is the age her Mother was when she died.
