John left Saturday night at 8:20. We sure did hate to have him leave. He did not want to go back and would be so glad if it were all over, so would we all. We had such nice times while he was here and wished you girls could have been here. He would like to have gone down to Long Beach to see you all but he helped Daddy as much as he could. Well Helen has been busy sewing make her a darling red suit and a navy blue slack suit - all wool. They are so very nice. Then La Var came Monday morning on the Portland Rose - Helen met the train - well I heard it - whistle soon after she left here and said "I know she cannot make it." well she called me up later and I said "did you make it," she said "I just did make it - across the track I mean at the crossing said there was a train

coming from Town too and she was almost afraid to cross. Said La Var saw her there and watched her race the train in and just did beat it. They went out to the Lake and had a good time then came home about five. Helen made a cake. I had meat and vegetables cooked. Helen and La Var washed the dishes. Then yesterday they went to Salt Lake - took the car. I think Helen will come home about Mon. She said she would write to you and J. E. when do you go to night school?
