The moon is so bright we have been studying the stars. we have two beds - close together right out in the open I said I wanted to be close enough to Dad to reach over and touch him. we are going down for the party tomorrow night! It is so good to have Jean and Helen home with us. Jean wants to go fishing. I hope we can for a short time I am wondering about the girls, some say it takes so long to get I mean that have just made the trip. I wish they could come tell them to write and let us know. It is blowing hard up here Wesley was sure covered with dust when he came in. I will try to write soon.

Just a line to let you know I am enjoying myself up here. It sure is good to get away from the army for a while. I have been helping Dad harvest the fall grain. We are going back up in a little while and see if we can't finish the rest of the fall grain. The spring grain isn't ripe so we can't cut it yet.

They had a welcome home party last night for Raymond Sparks, Woodruf Cook, & myself. We are all on furlough and the party was really nice. Seemed like the whole population of Dingle was there & then some. Well I must be on the way to Pine Springs. Love to all of you & I hope you are well,
