Was very glad to get your letter to night. It seemed so long since I had a letter from you. I am not feeling very good. I feel like I did last Spring when I went to Dr Rich. Hope I feel better soon. Helen does not feel too good she gets so tired all the time. I am glad when Friday night comes so she can have a rest. Well they closed the Dingle School to day on account of scarlet fever - Arrell went home at noon. It's like locking the barn after the horse has been stolen. Most everyone has been exposed. I called Norma to day - They are all well. She said Hershey called his Uncle Herbert in Paris last night - said they were snow bound at Fillmore Utah. She doesn't know when they will get here. There has been a big storm all over this part of the country James is in Salt Lake - will come soon as the roads are cleared. Mitchel killed a pig the other night and was taking it in to James yesterday after noon. He got as far as Bischoff in Hard

...s, when he had a "head on" with a truck -
a Utah man who hauls produce to the stores.
It seems he cut the corner and was over
on Mitchel's side says he couldn't get out
of the saucer Mitchel was out as far as he
could get and yet he ran in to him. Mable
& Lee were in. It nearly threw Mable thru
the wind shield - broke the glass out - but did
not cut her, but hurt her hand, neck, back,
and leg. It hurt Mitchel where it hurt him
last year - in the shoulder. He couldn't fix
to day and got Clifford to do it.
