The other boys promised Milton that they would either be there or have a man there as soon as I got ready, which was to be near June 15. Well I was sick and could not start until after the 20th, but if they had desired they could have done the excavating. Then when I did start the only help I had for nearly a week was a kid Patchel sent up. Then Kenneth came with his team for two or three fracturing of days. Rodney has not helped at all, but is praying Joe Lindsay for hauling gravel. But I hope to get Joe to do it and have to spend time to keep him at it when I need it. And so it goes. When Kenneth is

not sick or working for Rodney he has things to do around the house or places he must take Ruth. And Mabley finds things to use up Ma's spare time. Men are hard to get.

I gave them plenty of notice that I was going to work this week and then could not work until after haying. Did I get help? I worked alone yesterday. Kenneth came last night and said he had to take Ruth on a vacation today.

Mitchel may have the kid there today but he might just as well not, because I can't use him to advantage without an other man. And thing that he could do he does not know how with using my time to show him, then I can do them quicker alone. However I will have several crypts completed by the end of this week. The walls will not be up nor the roof on and I do not know when I can work on it again.

If you want to bring Dad up and put him in that way you can come any time after this week. Other wise it wont be until September and maybe later
