Dear Mother:

It has been so long since I wrote to you that I am ashamed of myself. There is no excuse except that I just haven't got at it. You know it only takes me a few minutes to write a letter when I am in the mood, but the hitch comes in getting the mood.

We have had an awful time getting the crops in. I figured on having my grain all in, my plowing all done and 33 acres for K.D. and 35 acres for M.A. cut by Oct first. This the way it has worked out. By Nov one I had all my grain in except 3 acres of barley and 2 acres of crested wheat grass. The barley was frozen so I gave up trying to cut it, and turned the outfit over to K.D. to cut his. He thought he would finish to day but did not. All of K.D.'s and M.A.'s ~~got so~~ and 35 acres of my grain got snowed on and flattened almost to the ground. We get just a little over half of it.

Well I am building a house at last. Mable's brother George is doing it for me. We have all the stumps on now and will have the windows in in a few days. Then will come

the inside work. We have to have a few
rooms finished so that we can begin them
by Xmas. I will start on the rock work
in the spring, it will be a summer.

It will be a beautiful place if I can ever
get it done. Everyone says that it is too
big. Well maybe it is, but we could not get
what we wanted in any thing less. And
I have an idea that some one will get
a lot of good from it after I am through,
any way I will have the satisfaction of
building it. I hope to be able to get it paid
for. If things are good for several years and
the taxes are not too high I will.

You will have to come up next summer
and see it.

Tell Ida that I was glad to get her check
and that I had not really needed it before.
Also tell her that the next payment will
be higher because Curtis's part is paid off.
So it leaves the two of us to pay what the
share paid before. But it will be over
sooner.
