Nov. 21, 1935

Dear Aunt Ida

I hope you are all well. We are. I should have written sooner but I have been so busy and then I would keep putting off my writing. I probably couldn't be writing now but I have it much else to do. and I expect Dad will be going down today.

I am herding sheep now. They have just gone over the hill and have to climb that hill. They are in tight again, every single one of them. There a jack rabbit scared them, I thought it might have been a coyote but it was only a big white rabbit. There isn't any snow and the rabbit looks fat. a little white spot trying to hide behind a sage brush but can't get entirely hidden. His ears keep moving too.

I am out away from camp on foot following my sheep and writing as I go. I hope you can read this. I have my paper on a magazine but it is rather hard to write well enough to read. I don't

have any part inf. not any stationary.

We have two head snows, Andrew & Johnson heads the tight wool ewes with the loose wool bucks & I head the loose wool ewes with the tight wool bucks. Dad is substituting for Andrew while he is in town. We are buying for wool. We are increasing our herd so we have that in mind.

Dad had good luck with his sheep. Dad's lambs beat Michels & Rodney's and they ran together. We shipped the same Quaker dist. O. C. L. We sold today & they sold Wednesday. We got 4.95 for our tops & 4 for our feeders. They got 4.90 for their tops & 4.25 for their feeders. We think we beat them at that. They had an extra days feed to pay for & then probably had to pay freight to Chicago. We had a large percentage of tops & they had a small percentage of tops.

I expect to get down there the first part of January. I will try to write again soon. Tell Ricky hello for me & I would like him to see all my sheep. 292 head. Lot of love to every one down there. Try to write again before I get down there. Good by for now. Your nephew now
