before they operated so we were all  
so glad he could come. It made

her feel better too. They let  
Nouns in to see her mother  
last night.

Helen went back with Milton  
to Salt Lake and will take  
the bus from there. It just  
made me sick to have her go  
Milton said she had a chronic  
case of appendicitis - He will  
operate down there.

I am feeling better -  
can go without my crutch  
around the house. And  
bend my knee bent a little  
more. I try to bend it all the  
time. It swells a lot and  
pains. I am drinking  
all the milk I can and  
am taking cod liver oil.

glad you are so well.

busy as ever. They will soon have the wild hay in and are working on Mitchels now. We have had frost - the grain is frozen but we did not have so much in this year.

We had a nice birthday dinner. Emeline did it. She made him a cake and got ice cream. Had candles on the cake it looked so pretty. She will be going home in a day or two. Mary Lee said she would like to live in Cal. We like the dress and the other things also.

I will try and write again sooner.
