Sept. 16, 1939.

Dear Mother & Pearl -

Dad has not
been feeling well for about a
week, but he is better now.
He felt he had a partial
bowel stoppage and sent for
the Spencer Rich. He had
them take him to the
hospital for a enema
treatment - Thurs night.
Last night Wesley and I
went down to see him. He
seemed to feel pretty good
said he was going home
tomorrow. The nurse told
me the oil went through
him and she thought
he was better, but that he

was worried about himself.
we sent a telegram to Milton
last night and I told Dad I
would write to you and tell you
all I could. This morning
I called the hospital - The
nurse said he felt better
this a.m. said he has several
bowel movements last night.
Dr. was not there yet.

we don't want you to worry

if we find any thing
from the Dr.
