Dear Grandma,

I am sorry to hear that Grandpa passed on an especially that he went so soon. I wish the boys had gotten there to see him. I wish I could have gone down with them but I didn't even get to see them as I was at the football game. I was thinking Grandpa was in San Pedro with Milton all the time, & I was surprised to hear he was in Long Beach. I am not very good at writing comforting letters but I am indeed sorry to hear such news. How is Aunt Ida & the kids? Well our Thanksgiving is over as in about half of the state.

Grandma Lorraine is about the same. She gets awfully tired & her joints are going stiff even as much as we move her about. It is 8 months today that she has been lying in bed on her back. She can't seem to lay on her one side & her back is getting awfully tired. We try to sit her up as much as we can. We prop her up on the side of the bed a little while each day & then when she feels a little better & we can we take her out in the front room in a big chair. I have

carried her out & back twice. She seems to feel better after she has been out in the front room.

I am busy as ever. Two weeks from today I have the final exams & they promise to be rather tough ones. There is only 17 left out of the class of 55 & so I don't know whether they are going to continue flunking any more or not. We are all studying hard hoping we pass.

I guess I will have this scar taken off my eye for my Christmas present. It isn't getting serious but with all my studying & reading it gets red & he says it might turn to cancer if it keeps on being irritated. I will have to see him & decide when to have it done but I think right after my exams around the 18th Dec. Doc Milton know about him. He is Dr. Stookey & is the school ear nose throat & eye doctor. I got my glasses from him & they seem to be fine. I haven't heard anything against him up at school. The streets are getting decorated for Christmas & all the stores have their displays out & the town is beautiful except for the smoke.
