We have got the foundation, and the floor of the Vault completed I expect to have the walls up by then of next week. Then we will have to wait for them to set before we can do the crypts, then will come the roof. I can't tell how long it will be. It depends on how much help I can get. I have to stock my alfalfa Monday if it does not rain again.

Then I can spend about ten days on the vault. After that I will have to put up the wild hay. If we do not get through by the wild hay we will have to finish up.

Why don't you and Ida come up as soon as you can and Milton can bring dad when everything is ready.

You know it is pretty slow work when one does not know from one day

(over)

to the next if he is going to have any help or how much. I could have had three men helping all the time it would not have taken so long. Some times I have been alone. The other boys have so many things that are more important. I have things to do too.

Well I will do the best I ~~can~~ and hope to have the crypts in in ~~two~~ weeks. You could bring him up then and we could put the top on later.

Every thing is doing fine here now. We are all well or nearly so.
