if you can. Montpelier went to Lefton
to get her ice to pull up and it was none too
good about six inches thick.

There is not much doing in the cattle
up here very little selling or buying
no money to buy and every one are look for
the market to go up and don't want to sell
the sheep at some what better we sold
the wool for 30c. will start lambing in 10
days hope the weather is good by then.
