if you can. Montpelier went to Lipton
to get her ice to put up and it was more too
good about six inches thick.

There is not much doing in the Cotte
up here. very little selling or buying
no money to buy and every one are look for
the market to go up and don't want to sell
the sheep are some what better we sold
the wool for 30¢. will start lambing in 10
days hope the weather is good by then.
