comfot to be seeing she has to  
set up most of the time. You need  
not say any thing about me sending it  
you can get it out of the office

and give it to her you cannot  
get it up in your rig so will  
have some one get it for you  
It might be Henry could hold  
it - if he went down it will be  
nice for her to have Sunday

Well we are having bad  
weather here & the roads are horrid  
I guess they are the worst I have
