This is Saturday morning I have got all of the work about the room done including a small washing and am going to start studying soon. Milton is at work, he has a job in a grocery after school and on Saturdays for \$6. per week.

The school here isn't so bad. There is a lot of study, they figure two hours out side to one in the class room. Most of our classes are lectured with a test each week to see we are studying. This does not include drawing, shop, or lab they certainly believe in having good time. We had a matinee dance every Friday afternoon. A football dance at hotel Utah every other Saturday evening, with class dances, frat dances and other entertainments thrown in. This week and next, we are having an extra amount of exams, they are known as the semi quarterly exams, given for the purpose of picking out every one that is not studying.

Have you heard from Dad telling when his go to Calif. I got a letter from Douglas tell that they were through thrashing and that Sabian's job was done. Milton and myself are both doing fine, and hope that all is well there.

Have you heard the latest about Theone? about three weeks ago uncle Hugh (H.C. Crockett) got a letter from him in the Pen at Salem Ore. They had him locked up for stealing an auto. His trial won't come off until Feb. so it must be a Federal case. He wanted uncle to send him some sigerets or some money to buy them with. He afterwards wrote, tell <sup>him</sup> not to bother, but he would like him to go his bail for 500.
