bound so he didn't get to  
see him. He said that

he could of had him trans-  
ferred to Utah juvenile court,  
but he thought it would  
do him good to stay where  
he is.

Milton's ear is getting better,  
but he still has to go and  
have the Dr. dress it. He  
can't hear as good with it  
as he can with the other;  
but his hearing will improve.  
We Engineers are the only  
ones with any pep in  
this school. The night before  
Thanksgiving about 175 of  
us painted the town.

Friday night the Engineers  
had a swell dance at the  
Hotel Utah grill. Milton

a fine time. I have found
