My Dear Friend

Dear Mrs. To you & welcome  
letter recd last Thursday. I  
take my pen this rainy morn-  
ing. To ans. We have been  
having very bad weather  
here the last week & I fear  
it will quit with a frost. If  
it does there will be some frozen  
grain in Bear Lake. Most of  
grain is ripe here in L. D.  
The binder would have commenced  
cutting for me tomorrow or next  
day. Had it not broken down  
I will have to go to Montpelier

to day + send far the part  
that was broken - which  
will not get here till Tuesday  
I think my grain is  
out of the way of frost  
If it does freeze it will not  
hurt it much my oats  
are very poor I will not  
have as much as I expected  
but the wheat is better so  
I will not be worsted any  
I have been taking  
things easy since I  
come home have worked  
but two days I was not  
feeling well + thought I  
would take a rest -
