Sept. would have been a better  
month but it will be myself  
& go then it seems unless  
we wait another year which  
I am not willing to do  
So as you may name  
the day and month I  
have it to you entirely  
What suits you best will  
please me so you can  
make arrangements & I  
may want to change the  
time on other events to consider  
that - It will know nothing  
of & I think it best that  
we set the time I will be  
ready any time after Nov.  
1<sup>st</sup>. So as you speak of the  
even as not being very important  
which surprises me & I was thinking  
it one of the most important  
one in my life if you can  
see what I mean a different life

Well if it is ~~not~~ impatient -  
with you I suppose it will  
make but little difference to  
the mother it may take place  
in, and should the trip not be  
as pleasant as it might have  
been I am willing to wait little  
I was want to make the trip  
pleasant & now have it in  
a good season of the year  
So I will not be down  
until Aug. As that I know  
now. Yes I will be very  
busy for some time strong  
harvesting & threshing  
Yes & that I do differ with

his promise I told <sup>him</sup> that was  
all I wished & all I wanted was  
my grain cut he said he  
would not leave any standing  
& cut another I told him mine  
was a head of theirs I did not  
want him to leave it for a  
other. He turned white & got quite  
excited & said he would cut it  
when he came to it & send word

him I would see that he  
come to it soon We had other  
words & I left the field see  
they had the desired effect—  
for he has just come & told  
me this morning that he would  
cut it & has sent word to those  
he promised that he would not  
be able to cut there now I will  
try & keep out of contention &  
quarrels as long as possible  
but one thing sure my rights  
has got to be respected by all  
men I do not wish to dominate  
& won't suffer it even if I must  
quarrel a little Right should be

of now when I get into such  
difficulties & it has a great influence
