I am very glad you are having

you coming home? I think
I will go home and stay around

it is about 15° below zero now.
I wish you would enquire, and
if you can get things much
cheaper there than in Utah I
will send the money and have
you get me a wrap of some

himself and sent it by express.
I am getting quite ashamed of
my old shawl (the only one I
have) I would not trust to
my own choice in buying
any thing

I wish I could be at home
Christmas but it is impossible.

We expect quite a good time here
are going to have a Christmas tree for the
children in the day room. I wrote
one for the poor people in the
evening which will be quite
amusing. I am one of the Committee
and will have to go to Exeter next
Saturday to help buy toys &c.
