I was very happy to hear from Beulah et. al. & Milton & how you lost work & what they were &c.

We are all well here & generally speaking - Each day comes so fast on the heels of the preceding one that it seems hard to keep things up to date.

It seems to be growing worse daily. Interruption followed by laxness. We are all quite well here & Milton's family seems to be doing quite well to - Their ups & downs seem to be quite under control.

As we look over the city we see many small gardens & have been wanting to go to Milton's to plant some potatoes but just not able to do so to date. I do feel that home gardens are going to be invaluable. Douglas & Kenneth & Dick are there & hope they are able to stay a long time. It is not pleasant to think of the war in any way concerning the boys going overseas - but it is a job to be done.

The other day I went with other boys of his age to a hospital test with the view of later enlisting their greatest value in this war effort. If we are to consider the post war condition many of these 18 year olds must be educated to replace natural losses.
