Sometimes I feel terrible when I think I do not write oftener when you write such enjoyable letters, but I am getting to be a very poor correspondent since I lost my Mother. I'm even guilty of neglecting Father.

I was disappointed I couldn't go with Douglas to see you. I had been "after him" ever since our return from Idaho to go to see you, but Nelle had spoken for that particular weekend so I couldn't leave too.

Tomorrow is our 15th anniversary and we had planned on getting away for a

few days, but I am afraid we won't. It is hard for Douglas to leave and Sunday seems the same as any other day - calls to make - phone ringing.

Mother & I, we are going to have a nice new home! We are anxious to get away from this lousy corner with our Baby. He is outside all his "waking" time and he isn't safe. We will have a nice bedroom on the main floor which I hope you will occupy "every now and then". We will have more room and we do need it. The plans and specifications are out to Contractors for bids now. I do hope we receive a reasonable bid.

Maybe, sometime, David and I will go down to see you. I want him to know his Grandma and you ought to hear him talk. He talks like a three or four year old. He said "when I get big I am going to be a Policeman." Forrest said "big, like Forest." He said "no, big like a Police man."
