Dear Brother: -

I have been going to write to you for some time, but have just put it off from day to day thinking I would be able to do a better job of it the next day or so, until days have turned to weeks. So I am taking time out to do it now.

We have been stacking hay for several days now and have up four stacks. The hay crop is good this year and all irrigated crops are doing nicely but the dry farms are pretty well gone. It has been two months or more without rain. It has looked like rain for about two weeks now but has done nothing until just now. Since I started this letter it has begun to rain. It came down fast for a few minutes so that I stepped out and drove the car to cover then it stopped but was set in again and looks like it would ~~last~~ last all day. It will be hard on the hay that is down but will be fine for the dry farms. It would have been better had it come a month ago but it will help a lot now.

Dad told me that you were not feeling so well now and that you were returning to Long Beach. I am very sorry to learn that such is the case for I had hoped that after a week or two at Berkeley you would be able to come on home for a few days at least.

It seems a long time since I have seen you and I am homesick to see you again, so if you cant come home it looks as if I would have to come to Call this fall to see you. I would like the trip and hope I will be able to raise enough money to make it.

The girls and Mamie are all to Sunday School except Jean, and he has just finished irrigating, has been at it for more than two days now.

We have a fine garden this year, both vegetables and flowers. I made three plantings of peas two and three weeks apart but they all come on about the same time so Mamie has been drying and canning what we could not eat. As soon as they is through with the peas there will be beets and chard, then beans and corn.

I hope you are feeling a lot better by the time this letter reaches you.

It is nearly fifty miles where they are, on slug creek. Mark Bush is here, will say good night to you. Hope to hear from you soon. Love from Mammie.
