Dear Wife

I got your
letter last night - she was dead
15 I had just got in with
the horses I had a real hard
time I was the first - man
that brought a team through
this year The snow is going
fast - between here & Soda I
think David can get through
by the 28 Snow is nearly
all gone will be by Mo. I
will expect David to
come down to L. by the 22
23 or 24 & get you & take you
as far as Pustor - & then
wait - till I tell you what day

to start I will write him
this morning to that effect
I think him to much of a
man to go back on his
word & leave me in the lurch.
I will meet you at Soda
If he want bring you over
I cant come after you till
I have all of the crop in which
will take me 2 weeks or more
I want you here I have
had a hard time getting here
& have made arrangements
for David to come & it will
put me out of it if he does
not come I think when
I write to him he will bring
you as far as Soda anyway
how that is if you
can stand it If you think
you cant you had not
better try it Now how I
want you to take good care

of yourself & not work
so hard. I am going to
see if I can get a carpenter
to work on the house this
morning it is getting so late
I would get some one to help
I think I will commence plow
soon I have but little time to
write you and have to write to
David so will close I am well
& feeling very good
