I am a little late in getting this letter off It has been on account of being so busy I do not think it wise for you to start right away If David is in Logan when you get this letter you can go as far as Preston & then wait till Mon a week there I think you will have a pleasant time but now the roads are bad & it will take so long to make it The furniture has come & is in M - now I have not got the house done yet have had a carpenter every since Mon & two yesterday My getting in so late has put me a way behind And I had to higher men & will have to get more I am afraid for the weather looks really I am real well & dont think I will weigh over 180 or 185 I have not had a letter from you for such a long time I hope you are well I would like to see you off & all Be good to yourself & dont come in the magon if you think you cant stand it Frank has not turned up yet so you had better come by way of Soda I dont think they can get through B.L.T. yet It looks like rain today & I have got to shingle too

I must meet Stewart at the river
this morning 20 min before sunrise so
will not write much Be good to yourself
& do as I have said got to Preston & wait
till the first Mo. May before starting

to the one that is mine. — I have caught a bad
cold waiting here. Stewart has not come yet &

a little while. Shaking down my coat
& not a very good coat & the soldier is cold
& damp & if Stewart don't come soon I will not
wait much longer. I want to send this today
you may not get it before Mo. Good morning
