it would have been well if I had

accepting Friday I worked my job  
I am feeling well but getting thin,

all very much! I miss you very  
more this time than ever before

I am thinking of a little plan  
I will tell it to you & see what you  
think about it. It is this, as soon as I  
get the house over & up of coming down  
after you & if John & Roxie wanted to come  
up of bringing them & have John help  
put up the first crop of lucern  
& then take you all back & let you  
stay till I got the wild hay up

If you approve of the plan  
find out in your own way (amingly)  
if they want to come if not let it  
drop — Well adl Ring you home

Friday morn. just as I got up he  
must have had a hard deal of it - he  
is quite poor I was glad to see
