biting so I will have to wait
till they get ready before I can
catch them They are coming
now but I'll write you & let them
wait till I get ready to catch them
O! here is some large ones
wait till catch one, What you?
As soon as I got my pole they
ran off, I don't think ~~the~~ writing
and fishing will work together very

well - I have been reading your
last and a queer one it is I will not
take it up for discussion here but
will write you tomorrow - Well
I can't write any more for the
fish are gathering & it will be
late before I get home so good
evening Will
