Be a student of the doctrines and principles contained in the inspired works that have been given in this generation, for many shall come unto thee to inquire concerning this great work of the Lord and through thy prayers and thy gifts, and the intelligence with which the Lord has blessed thee, and the inspiration of His Holy Spirit thou wilt be able to explain the doctrines of this church to the convincing of many of the honest in heart.

I seal every blessing upon thee that is for thy good, and reseal upon thee all thy former blessings. I seal thee up against the temptations that are in the earth, with an assurance that the things that are taking place with the nations of the earth are according to the plans of our Heavenly Father, for He has decreed that these things shall take place, that the earth might be prepared for the coming of His Son to rule and reign over the earth as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.
