As for myself I am thinking I will get better. Had a bad night & do yesterday. But will see if I can't hit something that will keep me going till Beulah ^{and} Ed comes. Have not done much yet - came in just a month, ^{to late} & lost all my planting last fall and to date have only got the piece E. & S. I got of Quayle plowd. Now am trying to get some one to help me for the rest. It look like I am just all most a failure ^{and} it will only be to bad for all interested as for one I can't take it with me. If I have any better luck will tell you later.

How ever wishing you a happy Mothers day Sunday. As Doug said over the phone I ought to be proud as we all went thru the depression and are on to ^{and} now had to go on.
