Dear Dad

I was glad to get your letter and know that every thing is ok. I'm down there & that you are feeling better. Was out to the Hot Springs the other night & Mrs. Bates asked about you & mother & told me to send you <sup>& mother</sup> her best regards. We are all well up here & doing fine.

We bought the cattle ~~now~~ we intend to sell in, to the home place & will start to feed in a day or so. It snowed a half inch yesterday but looks as tho it will clear up without any more. I have the fence upon the ocean ~~wave~~. Sold W. A. Lindsay sr. <sup>at 500 per ton</sup> 2 1/2 tons of hay & he is going to feed it there. The Star Valley men are bring their cattle ~~off~~ out now in a day or so & will pay ~~for~~ the rest ~~of~~ they owe. They want more than they made a deposit on so ~~can~~ letting them have it <sup>at 2500</sup> for the best one stack of real coarse at ~~300~~ <sup>300</sup> three stacks at <sup>400</sup> & all the rest I am holding at <sup>500</sup>. I used the Lindsay money to pay up the Fed Loan. How much <sup>money</sup> do you want me to send to you. How much kept on hand & how much

Paid to Fargillier C. Bankers. ~~The rest~~ I will <sup>some</sup> put on the debts I have with Montpelier Coal & Lumber & Thiel & Olsen Brothers. There will be around \$1400<sup>00</sup> on hand when I straighten up with Star Valley men.

I am enclosing a letter to you & one to me from Fargillier C. Bankers. I will write them that I will come up there this coming week & fix things. So tell me ~~first~~ what you want done.

Here is hoping you & all the rest have a pleasant Thanksgiving. Give my love to Mother & all the rest.
