and Kenneth.

Mr. May ask me to take

back in Long Beach now? I'll
have to write to them soon.

I was back in Los Angeles. That
was the best part of my Army career.
I certainly did have a wonderful
time on the weekend. Appreciate
very much all you all did for
me.

After getting lab now, so I'll
close now. Give my love to everyone.

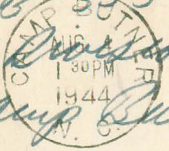
