Mr. Diehl has been working on various camp details, and seems to keep busy either in the garden, on the emergency squad or sanitary detail. Mrs. Diehl is now monitor of one of the buildings for mothers and children. The children are attending the camp school regularly. The family spend thier days in a Shack. They send love to the family at home.

(Santo Tomas University, Manila, PhilippinesIslands, is the site of an internment camp for civilians.)

December 13, 1943

Mr. and Mrs. Fabian Ream and children are at Camp Baguio and are all well. Mr. Fabian has been connected with the camp shop since his internment and is considered the most useful man in camp in view of his ability to work and repair anything required. Mrs. Ream is in charge of the women vegetable workers and also serves on women's committees. Her Children all attend schoolsin camp and are very active in camp socials and sports.

BAGUIO

The camp at Baguio is an internment camp for civilians, it is situated about half way between Manilla and the northern coast of the island of Luzon, Philippine Islands.
