The Provost Marshal General directs me to communicate with you regarding your son, Mr. Fabian Davine Ream, his wife Mrs. Ruth Ream, and their children, Mary Ruth Ream, Katherine Ream, Sara Lee Ream, and Fabian John Ream, civilian internees of the Japanese Government.

A cablegram recently received from Bern, Switzerland officially confirms their internment in Camp Holmes, Baguio, Philippine Islands.

You may direct letter mail to them by adhering to the limitations set forth in the inclosed circular and addressing envelopes as follows:

Your name is recorded in the files of this office as the nearest of kin of your son, Mr. Fabian Davine Ream, and of Katherine Ream, and Sara Lee Ream; the name of Mrs. Lone K. Johnsen is recorded as the nearest of kin of her daughter, Mrs. Ruth Ream and of Mary Ruth Ream, and Fabian John Ream.

When transportation facilities are again available for the shipment of packages to the Orient, a parcel permit will be forwarded to the designated nearest of kin.

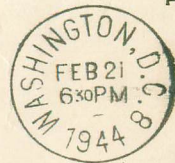
