Dear Mary Ida,

It has been nearly a week since I got your letter. I was very glad to hear from you, but have been so busy doing nothing that I have not got around to writing before.

I have quit feeding cattle and have branded them. There were twenty two to brand. Something hapend to two of the larger ones. I suppose that they made veal for someone though they may have did in the bushes where we did not see them.

I have planted a little garden, peas sweet peas, onions, cabbage ~~potatoes~~, lettuce and a few radishes and carrots. I have also been working on the back porch. I have it nearly ready for the concrete.

H.D. is in Pasatella for a bond contract for three days. Helen has not been offered a contract in Montpelier yet, no one has, but she has several other offers for a lot more money. Don't know what she is going to do yet.

We have had a lot of wet weather here lately.

I have been hoping it would clear up so I could get at farming. I was up to the ranch about a week ago, but was able only to get to top of the hill above the house. There was not much snow but a lot of mud. I will be going up again soon.

They have been having ward parties for the boys when they come home on furlor. Monday they had one for Veral Smedley. Nearly everyone was out. There was a programme with dancing after. They served sandwiches and pop. I was

asked to give the address of welcome. Sorry that Jackie is sick. I don't think that sleeping with here would be apt to give you anything. You have taken chances that were just as bad. I think though that it would be a good idea to have the test sometime when it is handy.

Hope you are getting along O.K. on the new deal with the K.D's.

I am glad that mother is improving tell her I will write to her in a few days. I must write to Aunt Ida too soon.

Give Pierre my best regards. I wish I could drop in on you for a visit.

Hope you are all O.K. now.

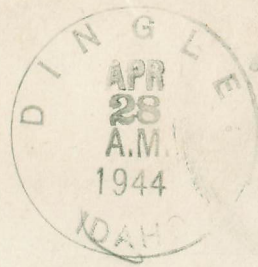
