Dear Grandma,

Time has certainly passed rapidly this summer. I sure had a fine time while I was down there.

Thanks for helping me have such a swell vacation.

Well I caught my first ride to Ventura & then I was stuck there till 2 hours had passed when I got a ride to Santa Barbara & had a hard time getting on. Four hours later I was merrily rolling along & got in San Luis Obispo about dark. Well I didn't expect much chance to get a ride after that so I bought my ticket on the bus & rode into Oakland. I called Aunt Helen up & then

went out to the fair. I saw  
about everything that wasn't  
too expensive & then Beatrice  
out to Uncle Milton & got there  
in time for a nice Chicken  
dinner about 9:00 P.M. The next  
morning I went over to San Francisco  
& around the Bridges & through  
China town & then out to Uncle  
Douglas. I had a good time  
there & spent the night there  
then that evening Uncle Douglas  
& Aunt Lucile took me out with  
him to make calls & to see the  
city lights at night. Uncle  
Milton told me he would give  
me \$5.00 if I would take the bus  
instead of hitching so I took him  
up & Aunt Lucile gave me a dollar  
for lunch money.

I found a travel Bureau that  
got me a ride to Salt Lake for \$7.00  
but catching buses & so on to get  
there I was 5 minutes late so  
had to stay over another night.

so I stayed out at Uncle  
Miltons again. He took me  
out with him to make some  
calls. I went out to see the  
house & it is more beautiful  
grounds & a large beautiful  
house they were still decorating  
& remodeling it & don't expect  
to get in it until about the  
last of this month. Well I  
had a nice trip home from  
San Francisco region & have  
been busy here in Salt Lake ever  
since. I didn't get up to the  
ranch & now school has started  
I don't know just when I will  
get up there.

I am sending you this money  
you loaned me before I spend  
it. My job at the store is  
only one night a week & has  
been ever since I left for  
home so I didn't lose much  
money by going on the trip but
