Dear Dad & Mother,-

I have been wanting to write to you for a long time but it seems that I just don't get at it. We are all well here now and doing fine except me and I threw my right shoulder out last Thursday while howling grouse on the road. I was lifting on a dump board when my left hand slipped and out went my shoulder. I put it back myself but have had to do nearly every thing since with my left hand. I saw a doctor and he said it was in alright, but that I should carry it in a sling for some time and not attempt much work with it. It hurts nearly all the time, but I believe it is getting better.

We have had fine weather here until the 12th when it snowed and now we have winter but not too cold. The sheep and cattle will do fine until the snow. The snow started at night and the next morning was about 16 inches deep at Pine Springs but it was fast rain in Dingle and was only 2 inches.

We had one bid on the steers. \$2.75 with 4 out entirely at \$2.00 leaving about 10 or 12 at \$2.75. I told them to go to —

I expected to have a little money for this year but it seems that I won't. I expect to get \$400 or \$500 before spring but it has a way of hanging off. Several hundred that I should have had now, I will not

one for weeks yet. So we are not having
much of a Christmas. Will here is hoping you
Best returns of the season.

The Home Loans are coming in pretty regular
now, I have 15 accepted and off turned down
so far. I expect to hear from you and mine
soon. I have ten or fifteen to hear from yet.
Since Dec 1, loan all being made through the
association. Well I will let you know as
soon as I hear anything.
