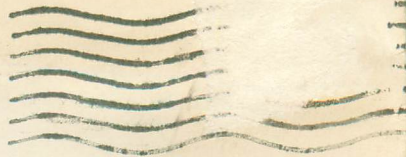
be gone. Nellie Sparks Bateman
