the Temple and done some work we had
to do before Delia went away and the
next day we all went to Lewis's Photograph
gallery and got our pictures taken Oh
Nora how we all missed you but we
done the next best thing I held one
of your pictures in my hand we have
not got them yet but Lewis says that

we are all taken good Delia ordered
a dozen of them she paid for two they
cost a dollar a piece we have not yet paid
for all of them Henry is saving up
his dollar to pay for his Delia has gone
she went last Thursday I do not know
whether any of us will ever see her again
it makes me sick to think of it she felt
awful bad not seeing you before she
went she said if you had let her
know in time she would gladly have
sent the money for you to come you may
be sure that we all felt bad because
you was not here with the rest of us all
here but you I think you would like to
have one of the pictures would you not
Mary is moving up to Preston and
I am so lonely I do not know what to do
or what will become of me I wish you
was living here Mary is going to sell
her place I wish you could buy it
how are you getting along and is the

snow all gone so the stock can live out
how many have you lost I hope not many
how is the law suit getting on I hope
old Larsen will not get the better of Will
I hope right will conquer when do you
think you can come to see us again I
hope soon Oh flora you must pray
for me pray for the Lord to help me
to bear up for I am very lonesome
for my children please write soon
to your loving mother kiss the
little darlings for me Love to you
