Dear Will - we got here all right - The folks were not looking for us. I got the three oldest boys in the Woodruff. Fabian would not go to school - he says he does not want to go to school this year - I walked all over town yesterday and have not found a suitable house. I could get one down by the depot but I don't want it down there & then it is not very suitable either. I have been thinking that I believe it would be better to let the three boys board all winter and one stay at home. I wish I knew what you think of this and if you agreed with me I would not look for a house. We are all well and hope you are all well.

I am so lame from walking  
I can scarcely walk at all. I  
am going down town again  
to see about a house that is  
partly promised to a woman  
and I can find out this afternoon  
if she is going to get it. I think  
I will ~~not~~ see if Mrs. Robins  
has got here yet.

Every body is well. I will  
be home Sat. morning if nothing  
happens to prevent.

I hope you are all well &  
Douglas & I da are all right.
