Dear mamma: -

I didn't get time to write last Sunday and havent had time since then on account of my work. I have a job of carrying papers from eight until ten oclock every evening

I carry all on the east side of Main Street, a fellow living right here carries the rest. I am sending you a map of my rout from the time I leave the depot until I reach my home street. The inked line represent my tracks, the crosses, the subscribers. I get four cents per paper per week for my work.

I went to a social the other night after I had delivered my papers, and ~~gave~~ took part in a short programme.

At the prep. assembly the last two weeks we have had interesting illustrated lectures. The first was given by Dr. Sage on Pompeii. The views were his own

photographs taken by himself.

The last one was on Burbanks given by one of his personal friends, the Californian state superintendent of public instruction. I enjoyed both immensely.

"Fifty" I held a competitive drill to select officers to fill the vacancies in the battalion. I got highest marks but an account of being a prep. was I had to take 3rd corporalship

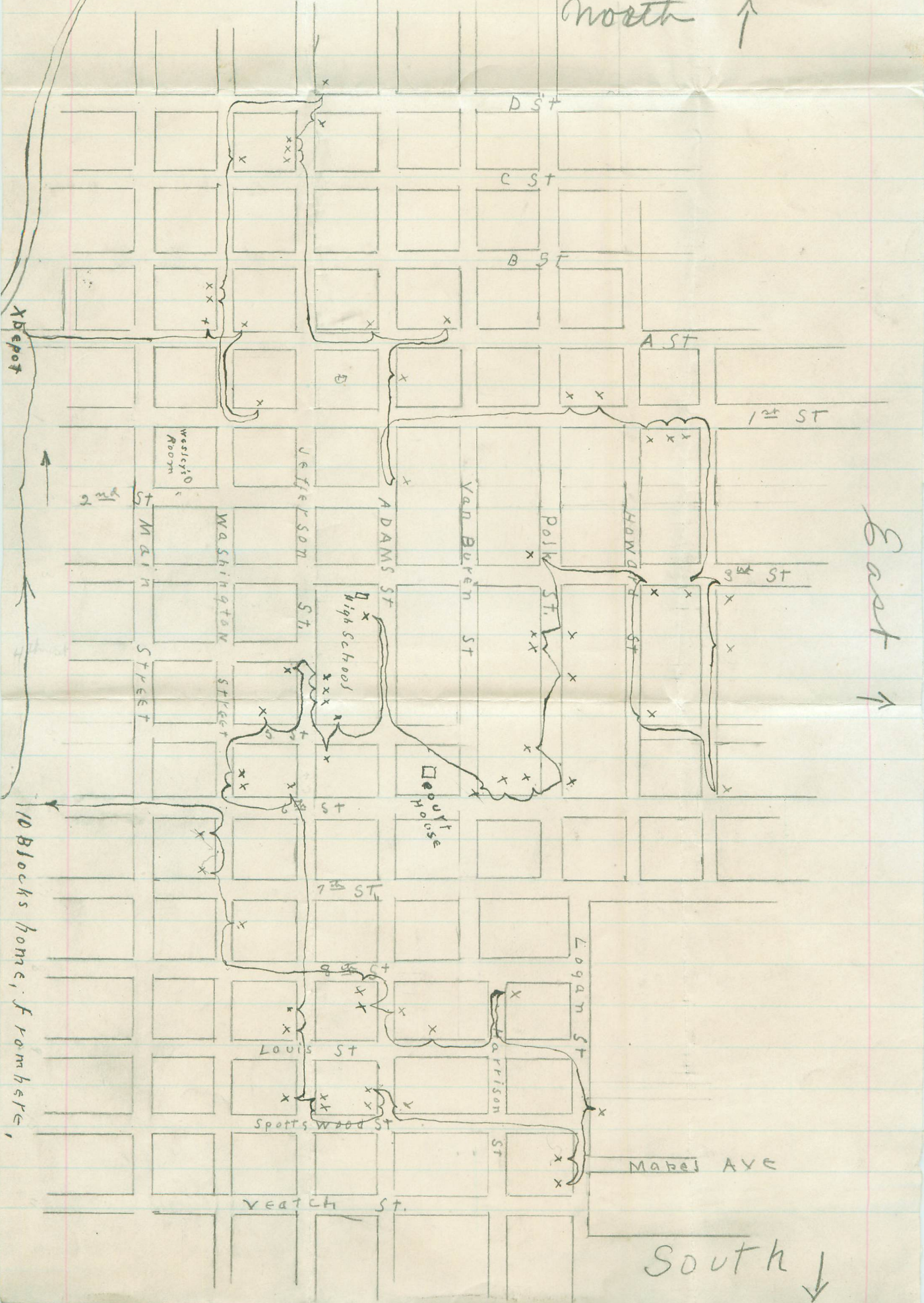

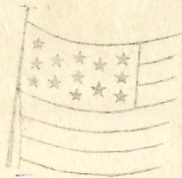
