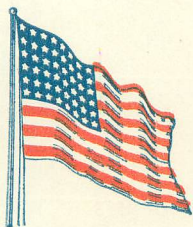
Sept 17 1918

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We are getting along pretty good (for) lefts here. One of the ward boys brings me some extra when ever they have more than enough for the trays.

Guess you can imagine how the patients look for the meals. We call it a show and certainly look for it. Did I tell you everyone has to wash his hands and face at 5:00 A.M. and then wait until 7:00 for chow? That is a regulation and they start the first morning after they are operated on.
