

Ogden July 5, 1885

My Dear Friend
I am still here in Ogden I did
not get away yesterday as
I expected Will be off by an
early hour tomorrow morning
We arrived here at 8 P.M. yesterday
& found all of the men preparing
for the procession I wrote
them from Brigham City
telling them I would be
near & P. They were just a
little vexed at me coming
but agreed to load me providing
I would put two teams on the
procession & help them to
get ready which I did.
Mr Turner said he would

have his part of the
possession drop out on 5th
and not get to the park
and by so doing would have
my loads by noon. The
programme commenced at
9 o'clock but on such occasions
they always allow 1 or 1 1/2 hr.
grace. In this case it was 1 1/2
& when they came to 5th. Turnover
was impossible so they had to keep
up the strike the park & did not
get back till 12 1/2 past - but all
of the we came back & was
ready to commence loading
leaving too very much. By this time
I was beginning to be some
interested & had almost come
the conclusion to stay.
The men promised to come early
Monday or even today if it would
only let them look up so I told

them I would wait until Monday
I am going downtown sooner than
I expected & will so cannot tell you
much of the 4. It was grandest I
have ever seen a perfect success
as far I saw I enjoyed myself
very well & thought of going
many times during the day a few
times & that was all day I don't know
which I think you would make a
better Goddess of Liberty than the
lady they had

Did I will be in Logan
on Tuesday evening or Wed.
morning early. It will depend
on the luck we have if no bad Tues.
will seem sure I have no time
to look for mistake in that
not will have them for you
to correct.
